Dastak Camp for Swat Internally Displaced People (IDP's)

Village Maloot, near Pind Begwal, Simly Dam Road, Bhara Kau, Islamabad.

Salient Features

- **Dastak Youth Organization** is a community/service organization designed to uplift the rural area of Islamabad, Pakistan.
- From middle of May 2009, large number of refugees flooded in the rural area of Islamabad, particularly Simly Dam Road vicinity. Dastak being a grass root organization in this area, felt obligated to take care of all the needs of these displaced citizens of Pakistan.
- **“Horizon International Trust”** is running a free school for under-privileged children namely **“House of Light School”** at Simly Dam Road, Pind Begwal , Islamabad.
- Horizon International Trust Organized camps and solicited help from the donors.
- We are providing food, shelter, clothing, medical facilities and educational programs for children.
- So far, we successfully sustained the ongoing efforts to help IDP's.

Horizon International Trust (HIT) and Dastak Youth Organization with the conjunction of Nomad Art Gallery are supporting IDP's from Swat and adjacent areas since May 2009. They are based in Village Maloot, near Pind Begwal, Bhara Kau, on the outskirts of Islamabad, Pakistan. Our support/donations consist of food rations, clothing, bedding, water containers, toys and medicines .we also have conducted art therapy workshops and set up medical camps at a central location which is accessible to the families. The donations are made by Horizon International Trust, Dastak Youth Organization and Nomad Art Gallery, friends and local philanthropists. Almost 50% of IDP's have gone to their native areas and others are still living in Dastak Camp under the support of Horizon International Trust.
